Students coming from countries classified as less risky (according to the list at mzv.sk):



May enter the territory of **Slovakia** without the obligation of home isolation and testing for COVID-19.



May check-in in the **student dormitories** of the University of Economics in Bratislava **from September 2nd 2020**.



During the check-in in the dormitories **complete and submit a self-declaration form** of health and travel history of the past 14 days (available at <https://euba.sk/aktivity-a-media/aktuality/1995-aktualizovane-opatrenia-rektora-eu-v-bratislave-c-11-k-sucasnej-situacii-20-august-2020>).



The **enrolment** of students to the study programme International Finance, and of foreign students to the study programme Finance, banking and investment (in English) will be carried out **in person on 18th September 2020** from 8.30 at the Faculty of National Economy in a lecture hall No. B108. A nostrified document of the qualification and one photo of a student is needed). For more information contact **Mgr. Jana Šipošová**.



To simplify the administrative process please **send by post**:

- a nostrified certificate of finished secondary education (for 1st level study),
- a nostrified diploma of bachelor's degree (for 2nd level study),

or at least the confirmation of application for nostrification of the above mentioned documents.

Students coming from countries classified as high-risk countries

(according to the list at mzv.sk):



Upon arrival in Slovakia **contact the Regional Public Health Office** and **take the COVID-19 test** on the fifth day after arrival at the earliest.

Remain in home isolation quarantine until receiving a negative RT-PCR test for COVID-19. Recommended facilities for home isolation quarantine: *Student Residence INCHEBA* and *Special Purpose Facility Gabčíkovo*.

May **check-in in the student dormitories** of the UEBA **after** completing home isolation in Slovakia and receiving a **negative result of the PT-PCR test** for COVID-19 after five days of home isolation.

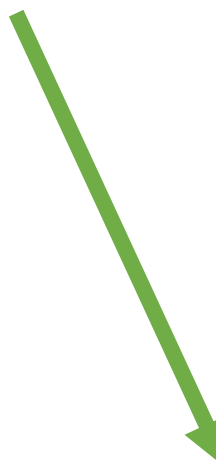
Green phase:

UEBA has neither an employee nor a student with suspected or confirmed COVID-19 disease

In case of entering the building of the UEBA, present a **student card** (new students, who do not have an ISIC yet, will present another ID).



In university premises respect **R-O-R.**
(rúško=mask, odstup =distance. ruky=hands).



Bachelor level of study (FBI in English):

From 28th September 2020 to 2nd October 2020 **online** lectures and seminars (MS Teams).
From 5th October 2020 **personal presence** on lectures and seminars is required.

Master level of study (International Finance):

From 28th September 2020 **online** lectures and seminars (MS Teams).

If symptoms of COVID-19 appear during participation in educational activities or during the working day, leave the university premises immediately using a mask, contact a doctor immediately and take other measures as instructed by the attending physician.

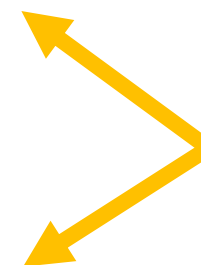

**Orange phase:
UEBA has a student or an employee suspected of having COVID-19**

Close contacts of a student with suspected COVID-19 disease:

Do not participate in the full-time form of education.

Report this fact to the contact person at the FNE (Mgr. Jana Šipošová).

In the case of a positive PCR test, full-time form of education for the entire study group will be suspended and lectures and seminars will be provided **online** (MS Teams).

In the case of a negative PCR test, **full-time form of education** is resumed, if close contacts do not show signs of COVID-19.

Lectures and seminars for close contacts of a student with a suspicion of COVID-19 disease will be provided online (MS Teams), for other students from the relevant study group full-time form of education continues.

In the case of a positive PCR test of two or more students or at least one employee, **the red phase measures** are required.

Red phase:
UEBA has students or an employee with a confirmed COVID-19 disease

Full-time form of education in study groups of positive students will be interrupted.



Close contacts of positive students will be excluded from full-time form of education.



Lectures and seminars will be provided **online** (MS Teams).

Full-time form of education will be renewed after the recommendations of the Public Health Office.
