

Profil absolventa	<i>Absolventi študijného programu financie, bankovníctvo a investovanie na prvom stupni štúdia (ďalej len „FBI“) získajú počas štúdia kvalitné teoretické základy z oblasti financií, bankovníctva, daní a investovania ako aj z problematiky hospodárskej a regionálnej politiky, či sociálnych a ekonomických vzťahov vo väzbe s najnovšími poznatkami a skúsenosťami z praxe.</i> <i>Skupina vertikálne nadväzujúcich študijných programov sprostredkováva profesionálne znalosti pre kľúčové profesie najmä podľa zamerania programu. Študentom ponúka osvojenie si základov ekonomickej teórie, poznanie ekonomických procesov, moderných analyticko-prognostických metód. Má kľúčový význam pre kvalitný výkon profesií, ktoré súvisia najmä s otázkami moderných financií.</i> <i>V rámci štúdia si študenti osvoja problematiku ekonomických procesov z mikroekonómie a makroekonómie. Táto skúsenosť umožní študentom efektívnejšie rozmyšľať v ekonomickom kontexte a zasadiť ho do ďalších špecifických oblastí akými sú daňová politika, regionálna politika, či verejné financie. Absolventi budú pripravení analyticky posúdiť relevantné politiky z makroekonomického i mikroekonomického hľadiska.</i> <i>Po absolvovaní prvého stupňa študijného programu FBI má absolvent základný rozsah teoretických a praktických poznatkov. Okrem toho získa základy pre prácu s empirickými finančnými a ekonomickými reáliami.</i>
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Graduate profile	<i>Graduates from the study program Finance, Banking and Investment at the undergraduate level of study (hereinafter referred to as “FBI”) acquire solid theoretical foundations in the field of finance, tax, banking and investment. These theoretical foundations are supplemented by economic insights, specific topics in regional policy, social and economic relations in connection with the latest knowledge and practical industry experience.</i> <i>The group of vertically connected study programs provide relevant professional knowledge which makes graduates demanded for the key professions relevant to focus of this study program. It provides students with essentials of economic theory, knowledge of key economic processes, in particular modern analytical and forecasting methods. These are crucial for the success at the job market, where the skills acquired in the study program match the needs and professional requirements in the world of modern finance.</i> <i>Within their study, students first learn about economic processes in the framework of microeconomic and macroeconomic theories. This experience enables students to think more efficiently in terms of economic context and how to apply it further in specific areas of tax policy,</i>
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	<i>regional policy or public finance. Graduates will be able to provide analytical assessment of relevant policies from macroeconomic and microeconomic point of view.</i> <i>After successful completion of undergraduate study programme FBI, graduate receives an appropriate range of theoretical knowledge and practical skills from this discipline, matching requirements of the lower ranked professional jobs in the field. In addition, they will gain elementary skills for work with empirical financial and economic tasks.</i> <i>Running this program in English mutation is a step towards fuller accommodation of current global development. The countries in the region are small open economies destined to work in the international environment, especially in the area of economics, finance, banking, and investments. Private and also public institutions are in permanent contact with their foreign counterparts. Therefore, studying this program in English could serve them as an extra preparation for the career to come and perhaps equip them even better for eventual job offer from abroad. Moreover, in the ever more internationalized world this program offers also an alternative for young people coming into the region, yet not mastering Slovak language or any other language of the neighbouring countries.</i>
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
